

FACTS	WHAT DOES AMERANT MORTGAG, LLC (“AMERANT MORTGAGE”), DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?		
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some, but not all, sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and credit history • Account balances and payment history • Transaction history and overdraft history 		
How?	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information, the reasons Amerant Mortgage chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Amerant Mortgage protect my personal information?	<p>To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.</p> <p>Amerant Mortgage uses cookies as part of our interaction with your browser. These cookies do not collect personal identifiable information.</p>
How does Amerant Mortgage collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply for a loan or provide account information • Provide contact information • Provide your income, employment and/or asset information <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account—unless you tell us otherwise.
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p><i>Our affiliates include companies with a common corporate identity of Amerant, and include financial companies such as Amerant Bank, N.A., and Amerant Investments, Inc.</i></p>
Non-affiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</p> <p><i>Amerant does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i></p>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <p><i>Our joint marketing partners include credit card companies, insurance companies, direct marketing companies, and companies that provide financial products and services.</i></p>
Other important information	
<p>This Privacy Notice applies to all consumer products or services that may be offered or made available. This Privacy Notice does not apply to any other product or service that you may obtain from Amerant Mortgage or Amerant Bank, N.A. All consumer personal information collected, processed, or disclosed is pursuant to the federal Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (Public Law 106-102), the Fair Credit Reporting Act with respect to affiliate sharing, and applicable implementing regulations. You may have other privacy protections under applicable law and to the extent applicable, we will comply with those provisions.</p>	

Vermont Residents: We will not share information we collect about you with non-affiliated third parties, except as permitted by law, such as to process your transactions or maintain your account. We may share your information with our affiliates, so they may market to you. However, we will not share information about your credit worthiness with affiliates.

California Residents: We will not share information we collect about you with non-affiliated third parties, except as permitted by law, such as to process your transactions or to maintain your account.

Nevada Residents: Nevada law allows us to make marketing calls to our existing customers listed on the National Do Not Call Registry. If you prefer not to receive marketing calls from us, you may be placed on our internal Do Not Call list by calling 1-888-682-2881.
